Why does climate change serve as a business opportunity?



Our survival has been threatened by climate change, a product of industrialization. As a response, the international community has adopted the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) and the Kyoto Protocol to prevent global warming.

Upon adopting the Kyoto Protocol, ways of reducing greenhouse gas emissions such as Clean Development Mechanism (CDM), Joint Implementation (JI), Emission Trading (ET) were introduced. This introduction was followed by the innovation of a new industry and a market mechanism. Under the Kyoto Protocol, carbon trading has become an inevitable task to accomplish, thus, the carbon trading market such as the CDM business is expected to grow significantly.

Lately a lot of countries around the world have been participating in the so-called "green race" to take the initiative, recognizing the role of the green industry and green technology as the new growth engines in the future global market. Last year, the Republic of Korea has joined this race, stating that the "low carbon & green growth" is a new cornerstone for the national development.

Climate change is now opening a new chapter in the history of business.
