Asia Pacific Responsible Care® Organization

Established to strengthen the chemical industry's Responsible Care® initiative throughout the region, the Asia Pacific Responsible Care® Organization (APRO) was formalized during the 8th APRCC (Asia Pacific Responsible Care Conference) in South Korea. KN-RCI (Indonesia) was among the signatories including regional and national associations, PACIA, AICM, ICC, JCIA, CICM, NZCIC, SPIK, SCIC, KRCC, TRCA and FTI. The idea to establish APRO initially starting discussed at the 7th APRCC – 2001 in Bali Indonesia or two years before 8th APRCC in Seoul.

The organization contributes to the development of the APRCC and greater cooperation among Responsible Care® practitioners in Asia Pacific region.

This year's conference upholds the APRO mission of facilitating the growth of Responsible Care® initiative along with information sharing activities across chemical industry.

The 12th APRCC with the theme "Road to 2020 World Summit on Sustainable Development (WSSD) Goal – Implementation of Global Product Strategy (GPS)", aims to discuss the issues and challenges in Responsible Care® and GPS implementation and its relevance to the global chemical management to achieve target of the 2020 WSSD Goal.

International Year of Chemistry, IYC-2011

This year we have a very special moment to celebrate the International Year of Chemistry. The year 2011 has been declared International Year of Chemistry (IYC-2011) by the General Assembly of the United Nations which launching took place on January 27-28, 2011 at the UNESCO Head Quarter in Paris. We allocate one session in the APRCC and invite guest speakers to present topics related to the achievement of chemistry and its contributions to the well-being of humankind.

Another important event, the Conference features exhibitor booths for conference sponsors and industry suppliers. We call "the Chemistry Exhibition" would be held in conjunction with celebration of IYC-2011 from October 26 – 27, 2011 at the same venue. The exhibition of chemical companies and service providers to exhibit their efforts in implementing Responsible Care®, Safety, Health and Environment practices, as well as to promote their products and services.

Global Product Strategy (GPS)

GPS is designed to help us achieve our vision where the public values our products and trusts they are responsibly managed throughout their lifecycles. In addition we need to advocate with regulators to view GPS as a great alternative to reduce risk compared to rather costly and bureaucratic regulations which may not.

The 12th APRCC encourage the Asia Pacific regional to implement GPS as important contribution of chemical industry to achieve the 2020 WSSD Goal.
